

REFERRAL SERVICE FOR "EXOTIC" SPECIES, CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY

INFORMATION FOR REFERRING VETS:

This is to let you know that from February 2010, initially for a trial period, the Queen's Veterinary School Hospital will be hosting a referral service for "exotic" animals (mammals, birds, reptiles, amphibians, fish and invertebrates) which will be conducted by Professor John Cooper, Wildlife Health Services, who is a renowned specialist in this field.

The service will enable practising veterinary surgeons to refer cases for a specialist opinion and for certain investigative tests. After the consultations the patient and the client will return to the referring veterinary surgeon for the appropriate, recommended, treatment or action.

The first referral clinic will be held at the Queen's Veterinary School Hospital, Madingley Road, Cambridge CB3 0ES, on Wednesday 3rd February. Consultations, by appointment only, will start at 11.00 and continue to 16.00.
