

Connecting to shared folders on vet–ifs macOS

Before connecting to the folders please ensure you've correctly configured and connected to the Vet VPN

Connecting to vet-ifs Group folders

Go to the **Finder** app and select the '**Go**' > '**Connect to Server**...' (or as a shortcut press the \mathbb{H} + K keys when in Finder).

- 2. Click on the '+' to add the server address to the '**Favourite Servers**' list (you only need do this once to remember the volume mount path).
- 3. When prompted enter your username as 'AD\yourUsername' (eg AD\abc123) and your password is your normal login password for your computer at the Vet School.
