

Connecting to shared folders on Vetmed IFS macOS

If you are connected to eduroam you do not need Vet VPN. If you are off-site, e.g. at home, then you must first connect to Vet VPN before attempting to connect to the IFS share.

Connecting to Vet IFS shared folders

Go to the **Finder** app and select the '**Go**' > '**Connect to Server**...' (or as a shortcut press the \Re + K keys when in Finder).

1. In the Connect to Server dialogue box type

- 2. Click on the '+' to add the server address to the '**Favourite Servers**' list (you only need do this once to remember the volume mount path).
- 3. When prompted enter your username as 'YourCRSID' (eg **abc123**) and your password is your Raven password.
